

This document describes the measures taken by Anchorage Sportsplex, Inc. ("The Dome") to minimize the spread of COVID-19 during its Flag Football program. It is subject to change in the face of new information, updated best practices, or government order. These protective measures are based on advice from public health experts and are intended to protect The Dome's employees and the public.

- I. Entrance to the facility
 - A. No one who is exhibiting symptoms or who has knowingly been in contact with a suspected positive case of COVID-19 within the past 14 days will be allowed to enter The Dome.

- II. Face coverings
 - A. During Flag Football games and practices, every person on the turf, including employees, coaches, players, officials, and spectators, is required to wear a suitable face covering.
 1. Face coverings must cover both the nose and mouth.
 2. Coverings must be of a design and manufacture effective for containing exhaled aerosols, and must be worn properly.
 3. Players may remove their face coverings while playing.
 - a) Players on the sideline are required to wear face coverings.
 4. The face covering requirements are in effect regardless of an individual's vaccination status.
 5. Coaches, staff, and Dome management will ensure compliance with face covering requirements.
 6. This requirement supersedes The Dome's "masks recommended" policy during scheduled Flag Football hours.
 - B. Persons located in areas of The Dome other than the turf, including spectator areas, are strongly encouraged to wear a proper face covering.
 - C. Employees are required to wear face coverings at all times.

- III. Handwashing
 - A. The Dome will provide sufficient facilities to allow employees and the public to routinely wash and/or sanitize their hands.
 - B. The Dome will require employees to wash their hands routinely.
 - C. The Dome will encourage customers to wash their hands routinely.

- IV. Cleaning and sanitizing
 - A. All sanitizing will be performed with a sanitizer listed on EPA List N.
 1. The Dome will maintain adequate supplies of sanitizers and supplies.
 - B. All balls will be sanitized before each game.

- V. Drinking fountains and vending machines
 - A. The Dome's push bar drinking fountain will be shut off and blocked from public access.
 - B. The Dome's touchless water bottle filler will remain open and be sanitized hourly with a food-safe sanitizer.

- VI. Response to Confirmed Infection
 - A. Upon being informed of a confirmed positive case of COVID-19, The Dome will respond in accordance with the CDC guidelines in effect at that time.
